

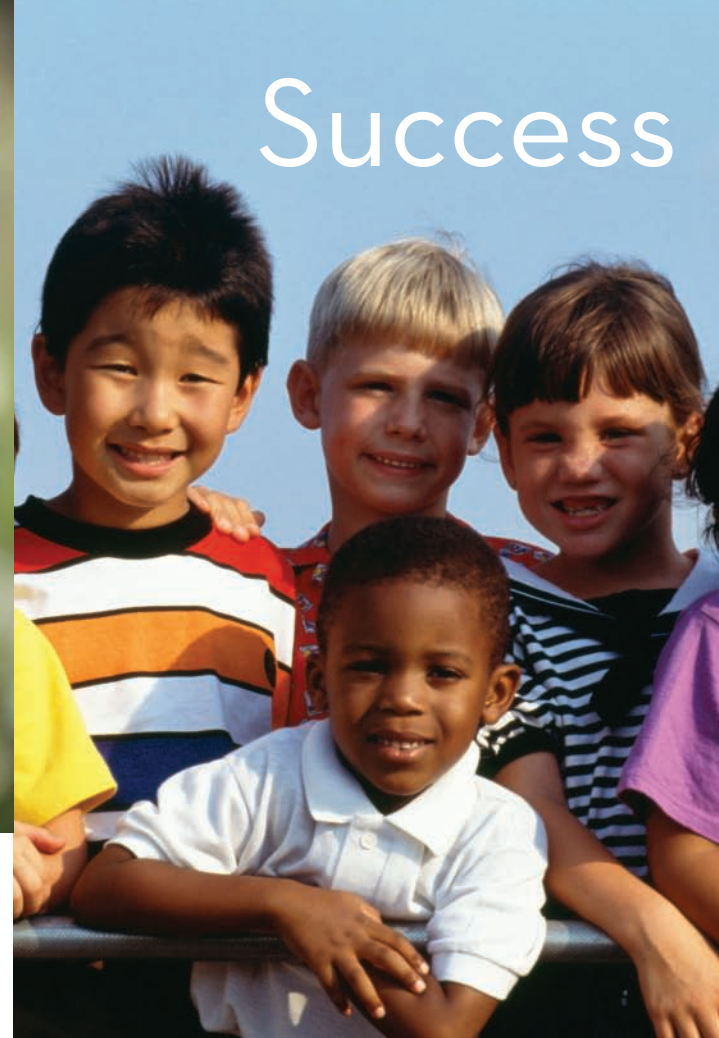

Homes with Heart separates itself from other foster family agencies with a team of skilled professionals who are genuine, compassionate, and possess over 50 years of experience in the field of social work.



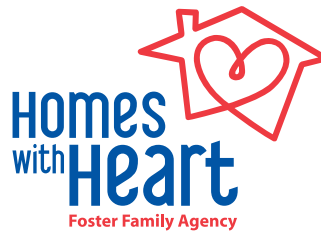

WHO ARE FOSTER FAMILIES?

Foster families are people who enjoy parenting and who are willing to share their homes, time, energy, and love with children who have some special needs due to abuse, neglect, or abandonment.

You can become a foster parent if you:

- *Are at least 21 years of age*
- *Are financially able to provide for your present needs*
- *Are single, married, divorced, or widowed*
- *Attend required training sessions*
- *Consent to criminal record and child abuse registry checks*
- *Are willing to work as a treatment team with the agency*



OUR MISSION

Homes with Heart understands the difficulties foster children experience: they require warm and loving homes that meet their specific emotional and physical needs.

In addition to providing potential parents the necessary information and training to be successful foster parents, Homes with Heart carefully monitors parent-child relationships and provides support and guidance.

MYTH: *I could never be a foster parent because I'm not married and don't make a lot of money. I don't even own my own house.*

FACT: *There are no such requirements. You can be married or single, a homeowner or renter. The only financial requirement is that you have enough income to support yourself and your family aside from the financial stipend you are provided to care for foster children.*
